Statement of Representation Procedure and Notification of Public Consultation Submission Local Plan: 6 January – 17 February 2022

Regulation 19, 20 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) regulations 2012

The Proposed Submission draft of the Croydon Local Plan (The Plan) sets out how the borough will deliver good growth that responds to the national housing crisis and the global climate emergency. The Plans vision is to plan for future development to meet local needs in a sustainable way that remains relevant. The Plan contains strategic planning policies which will positively shape the future of communities in Croydon and will be used in the consideration of planning applications.

The Plan covering the whole of the borough of Croydon is being made available for representations Thursday 6th January - Thursday 17th February 2022.

Making a representation

Any representation will be required to comment on whether you consider The Plan to comply with legal requirements, the duty to cooperate, and whether the document is sound.

Representations must be received by the borough council no later than 5pm on 17th February 2022 or they will not be considered. All representations received within the statutory consultation period will be submitted to the Secretary of State, who will appoint an Inspector to carry out an independent examination of The Plan and its evidence base.
