


## **How to use your Nominated Neighbour Card**

#### **Before you use your card**

Before you use your card, arrange with a trusted neighbour or a member of your family who lives nearby to be your "Nominated Neighbour".

Ask them if they will prepared to help you check out the identity of any person who calls at your door and accompany them into your home while they speak to you

Once you have found your "Nominated Neighbour" write their address into the space provided on your Nominated Neighbours Card.



#### **How to use your card**

- Keep your card near your front door.
  DO NOT DISPLAY IT IN A WINDOW.
- When someone calls at your home, try to look through a window to see if you recognise them. DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR.
- If you don't recognise them put the chain on Your door before your answer, TAKE YOUR TIME they will not mind waiting.
- 4 Open the door and show them your card. DO NOT SPEAK TO THEM.
- 5 Give them a few moments to read your card and close the door. Keep the chain on.
- 6 If you have a telephone, call your Nominated Neighbour, tell them you have had a caller and they are coming to speak to them.
- 7 Wait for the caller to return with your "Nominated Neighbour".

Remember genuine callers will not mind waiting. It is your home. You do not have to let anyone in.
